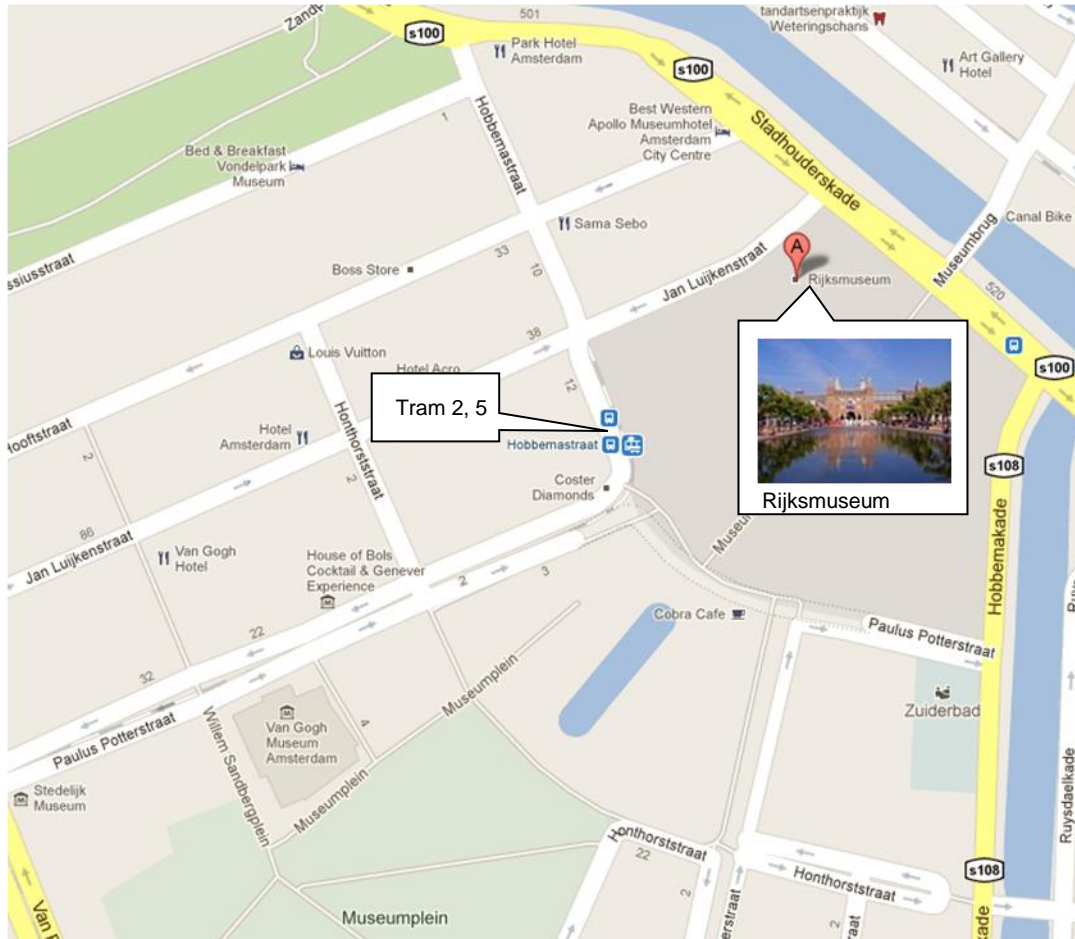


Practical information

The sixth symposium of the ICOM-CC Working Group Art Technological Source Research, Monday 16 and Tuesday 17 June 2014 at the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam.

The Rijksmuseum Amsterdam is located at the Museumplein.



Tram 2 and 5 stop at the corner of the **Rijksmuseum, Hobbemastraat**.

From Schiphol Airport to Museumsquare

At Schiphol Airport you can take a train to Amsterdam Zuid (WTC). Train tickets are available from the yellow ticket machines at the baggage claim area or the ticket offices at Schiphol Plaza. This journey takes 10 minutes.

At Amsterdam Zuid (WTC) Station take **Tram 5** (direction: Amsterdam Central Station). At Amsterdam Zuid (WTC) the stop for tram 5 is located across from Zuidplein (Zuidsquare); when you exit the train station, walk past the World Trade Center and go up the stairs at the overpass. Exit at the stop Hobbemastraat. The journey from Amsterdam Zuid (WTC) Station to the Rijksmuseum takes 18 minutes.

From Amsterdam Centraal Station to Museumsquare

When you walk out of Amsterdam Centraal Station you will find the stop for **tram 2 or 5** to your right. The journey from Amsterdam Centraal Station to the Rijksmuseum takes 20 minutes.

Tickets

You can buy a ticket for the public transportation from the driver of the tram or at the GVB office at the train station. There are one-hour tickets or day tickets.
